

## Promotion Restrictions

### **\$500\* off first month rent & No Admission Fee**

\*Restrictions apply. Offer expires Month/Day/Year.

\*Referral must move in and stay a minimum 30 days to qualify for offer. Respite stays and admission of individuals on hospice care are not eligible for this promotion.

- Promotion must be mentioned at time of tour to be eligible for promotion.
- Cannot be combined with any other promotion during same time period.
- Resident must move in prior to the expiration date of the promotion offer.
- Promotion expires on 11:59pm CST on the last date of the promotion unless a change is modified or communicated.
- Offer can be modified or terminated at any time without notice prior to a resident's actual move-in.

### **Friends and Family Community Referral Program**

**Get \$250 when you refer a friend\***

**Refer Two Friends\* - \$500 cash.**

**Refer Three Friends\* \$750 cash.**

\*Referral must move in and stay a minimum 30 days to qualify for offer. Respite stays and admission of individuals on hospice care are not eligible for this promotion.

- Promotion must be mentioned at time of tour to be eligible for promotion.
- Cannot be combined with any other promotion during same time period.
- Referred resident must move in prior to the expiration date of the promotion offer.
- Promotion expires on 11:59pm CST on the last date of the promotion unless a change is modified or communicated.
- Offer can be modified or terminated at any time without notice prior to a referred resident's actual move-in.
- Certain referrals may not be eligible for a referral bonus due to contractual or regulatory reasons. If a referral is not eligible for a referral, this will be communicated to the person making the referral prior to the resident's move-in date.
- Payout will be no later than 30 days after resident referral has moved into Community and stayed 30 days.
- Persons claiming a referral promotion will be required to provide certain information (name, address, social security number) for accounting and tax purposes before any payment may be made.
- Community must report any monies received by a single individual in a single year over \$600 to the IRS and the state Department of Revenue. For any amounts \$600 or more, a 1099-NEC will be sent to the recipient.
